# HOW TO USE THE AMERICAN CANALS INDEX

Every article that was published in AMERICAN CANALS is indexed by means of a one-line entry in the following four-part format:

23-8 (or v28n1-8) Lastname, X.Y. The Panama Canal [B4-65]

23-8	Refers to AMERICAN CANALS, issue No. 23, page 8.
V28n1-8	Refers to AMERICAN CANALS, volume 28, number 1, page 8 (1999 and later)
Lastname, X.Y	Is the author's name and initials.
The Panama Canal [B4-65]	Is an example of the title of an article that appeared (originally) in AMERICAN CANALS [B4-65] Refers to, volume 4, page 65

The last (fourth) part of an entry - [B4~65] in the example - will be present only if the article was reprinted in one of the volumes of THE BEST FROM AMERICAN CANALS.

Under a given heading or topic, the titles of articles on that subject are listed in alphabetical order; consequently, articles dealing with the same sub-topic will be found listed together - for example, under New York, articles dealing with the Erie Canal will be found grouped by use of a sub-heading, such as this one:

Because topics (titles) are listed in alphabetical order, author's names could not be listed in alphabetical order. A separate author index and a picture index is included on the web site.
